

INTRODUCTION

The licensing of swim meets with World Para-Swimming allows swimmers' times achieved at these competitions to be added to the World Para-Swimming (WPS) Rankings. Once a license has been granted by WPS, it will allow any athlete with a WPS licence to claim a European or World record (subject to meeting all of the criteria laid out in the relevant rules). Only athletes with a valid WPS licence can claim European and/or World records.

At this time, as the recognised body, it is only Aquatics GB who can make license applications to WPS. Therefore licensing applications for all domestic meets (such as County, Regional, District, National Championships and club Open Meets) must be done through British Para-Swimming. World Para-Swimming rules state that there is a fee of €100.00 and the application must be completed and approved by them 42 days before the start of the competition or an additional fee of €50 is due.

PROCESS

- Return the completed form to emma.turland@aquaticsgb.com with a Pool Survey carried out within the past 2 years and the meet entry pack must also be included
- In order to meet WPS deadlines this must be done 70 days before the competition start date an additrional €50 fee may be charged by WPS if this deadline is not met
- Aquatics GB will review the application and submit it to World Para Swimming for their approval
- Fees will be paid be AquaticsGB and charged back to competition organisers
- Competition results must be submitted to emma.turland@aquaticsgb.com within 10 days of the end of competition
- Results must be submitted in the WPS excel template format supplied to organisers aswell as the pdf official results book
