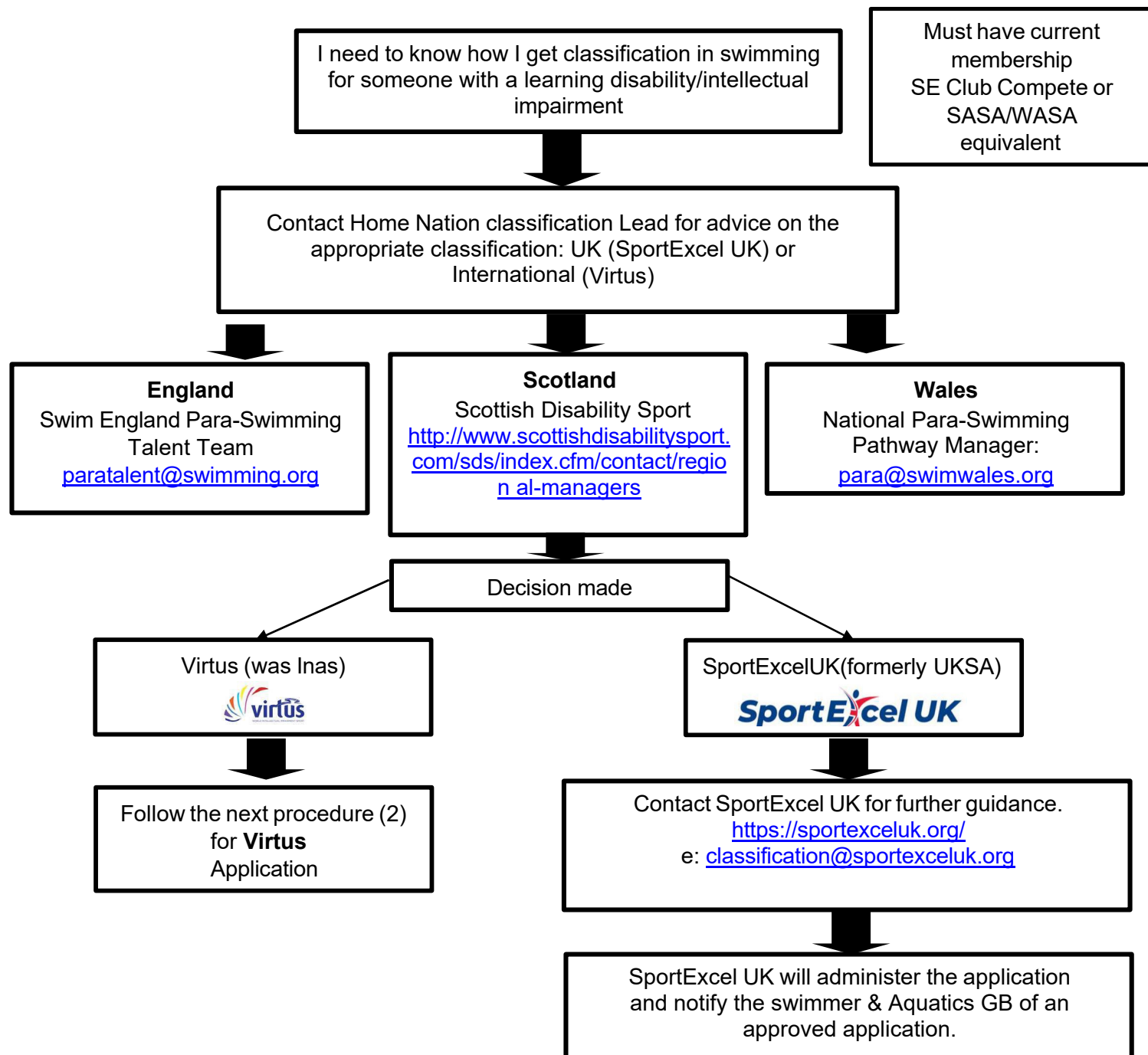



# Intellectual Impairment Classification

## Step 2 Procedure for Virtus Classification Application

 **Virtus** Classification required

Does the swimmer meet the required eligibility criteria of:

1. A full scale IQ score of 75 or below
2. Evidence of significant limitations in adaptive behaviour
3. Evidence of age of onset before the age of 18

Gather supporting documentation and evidence

- a) Photo with name on reverse
- b) Photograph page of current passport
- c) IQ test & report - Fully completed & signed and in correct format
- d) Copy of IQ Summary sheet (raw scores).
- e) Adaptive behaviour test & report - Fully completed & signed and in correct format.
- f) Copy of Adaptive behaviour Summary sheet (raw scores).
- g) Evidence of Age of onset both documentary if available, but always with summary statement in psychologist reports.
