The technical meeting will take place at **17:30 on Wednesday 4**th **June** in the training room at Sandwell Aquatics Centre.

DIVE SHEETS

Divers/Coaches are requested to submit dive sheets electronically, both for their own convenience and to minimize the chance of errors loading the data into the Recording program. Coaches may make bulk submission of dive sheets on behalf of their divers by using the program DiveSheets with which they will already be familiar. Alternatively, individual divers may submit their own dive sheets on-line. Please agree with your coach which method you should use. To submit your dive sheets on-line there are two options:

- Either visit: www.diverecorder.co.uk/onlinesheets and follow the instructions, or
- if you have an Android phone or tablet, you can get the ADiveSheets app from this page on the DiveRecorder website: www.diverecorder.co.uk/dive/android

As soon as you complete either on-line submission method, you will see a success/failure message.

Electronic dive sheets must be submitted where possible. Electronic submissions must be made by 18:00 on Tuesday 3rd June 2025. You will be asked to sign hard copies of these sheets at the venue, available from the Recorders.

If neither you nor your Coach are able to use the above electronic methods, you can submit a hard copy of your lists of dives to the Recorders at Sandwell Aquatics Centre.

If manual dive sheets need to be submitted, submissions must be made by 2 hours before the Technical Meeting.

For late entries, please do not submit a dive sheet until the late entry has been submitted and processed.

















EVENT CONDITIONS

Event Conditions for Aquatics GB Diving Championships 2025

1. GENERAL

- 1.1 British teams with British eligible divers have an unlimited number of entries, but they must have achieved the respective performance standards in the preceding 12 months (See Table 1.3).
- 1.2 Members of International Federations who are also members of British clubs may enter under their British Club, but will follow rules 3.1-3.3
- 1.3 Divers must be aged at least 11 years by the 31st December in the year of competition.
- 1.4 Late Entries for all events are allowed up to the start of the Technical Meeting, subject to 1.1 above. All late entries will incur a late entry fee. The late entry fee for Synchro will be at the discretion of Aquatics GB Diving Head Coach.
- 1.5 Divers may compete exclusively in synchronised events.

2. EVENT FORMAT

- **2.1** Individual events: there shall be 1m, 3m and Platform events. See Table 1.1 for more information.
- **2.2** No dive may be repeated in any event.
- 2.3 Individual platform dives can be performed from 10m, 7.5m or 5m platforms in prelims and finals. Priority of progression into the platform finals will be given to divers completing their full list from 10m. Any places in the final not filled by those with full 10m platform lists will then be available for divers performing some of their platform list from 5m / 7.5m boards based on points scored in the prelims.
- **2.4** Synchronised events: there shall be 3m and 10m events. See Table 1.2 for more information.

3. FINALS

- **3.1** In the final divers will perform their dives, competing in the reverse order of their preliminary rankings.
- **3.2** The finals will consist of 12 divers, ranked from the preliminary event, at least 6 of which must be British divers.
- **3.3** Up to 6 international divers may proceed to the final, but only if they rank in the top 12 in the preliminary event.
- **3.4** Following condition (3.3), the remaining places in the final will be comprised of additional British divers in ranked order. This may include British divers originally ranked outside the top 12 in the preliminary event.
- **3.5** All Synchronised events will be straight finals.

















4. GUESTS (INTERNATIONAL FEDERATION ENTRIES)

- **4.1** Evidence shall be provided, at the time of entry, to confirm that each foreign diver has achieved the performance standard (Table 1.3) for the event they are entering.
- **4.2** Multiple club entries from one country will be treated as one International Federation for final qualification purposes.

5. AWARDING OF AQUATICS GB CHAMPIONSHIPS MEDALS:

- **5.1** Divers eligible to compete for Great Britain are eligible for British Medals. In all events there will be Open and Closed medals.
- **5.2** Open medals will be awarded if a diver not eligible to compete for Great Britain, placed in the top 3 in a Final.
- **5.3** In Platform competitions, only divers performing ALL dives from the 10m board are eligible for medals.

6. SELECTION TO BRITISH TEAMS

6.1 Divers wishing to be eligible for selection in platform competitions for either Team A or Team B must compete all dives from the 10m platform. All selections will be based upon the published Selection Policy.

DOPING CONTROL

By entering this event the athlete consents to report to Doping Control, if requested, at any time during this event and agrees to abide by the <u>British Swimming Anti-Doping Rules</u> (2021).

If an athlete is subject to doping control, they should ensure they provide detail of all medications (prescribed or over the counter and including dosage) and supplements taken within the last 7 days in advance of the test and (where the sample collected is a blood sample) blood transfusions within the previous three (3) months, on the Doping Control Form. Any previously disclosed medications or supplements to your club and/or your home nation do not form any part of doping control.

If the medication you are taking is prohibited in or out of competition you may require a TUE. Please read the details below.

Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE)

If an athlete **IS WITHIN** the National TUE Pool they are required to obtain a TUE before using a prohibited medication or method. You can check if you are within the National TUE Pool via https://www.ukad.org.uk/national-tue-pool and selecting 'aquatics'.

If an athlete is <u>NOT</u> within the National TUE Pool but using a prohibited medication or method <u>and</u> is subject to doping control they are required to apply for a retroactive TUE and you should contact Jane Smith (<u>jane.smith@aquaticsgb.com</u> or 07917 834785) as soon as possible after doping control. A retroactive TUE must be submitted to UKAD within five (5) working days of the testing taking place.

Strict Liability means and athlete is wholly responsible for any banned substance found in their system, no matter how it got there.

ACCREDITATION

All competitors, coaches, chaperones and support staff must have a valid accreditation to gain access to athlete areas at the event. Accreditation is non-transferable and must be always worn when accessing athlete areas.

If the pass is forgotten, lost or mislaid, a replacement pass will be re-issued for a fee of $\underline{£10.00}$ at the Sport Information Desk.

ATHLETES

Your accreditation will be sent to you by email in PDF format upon completion of your entry. Please print and bring with you to the event where you can collect a pouch and lanyard from the Sport Information Desk.

COACHES, TEAM STAFF, CHAPERONES

All coaches, team staff and, chaperones and must have a valid photo to gain access to the pool deck. Applications for coach/chaperone passes will be charged at £10.

A valid DBS check, safeguarding qualification and fulfilment of the minimum qualification/requirement for the specific role (stated below) you are undertaking is required.

Swim England

All Swim England clubs and license applicants will have completed a DBS application regardless of any previous check carried out through another organisation unless this has been registered with the DBS Update Service www.gov.uk/dbs-update-service. If you hold a disclosure that has been registered with the DBS Update Service, and you have not yet given the Swim England written consent to check the status, please submit your original disclosure certificate along with a completed consent form to dbs@swimming.org for a DBS Update Service Consent form.

Scottish Swimming/Swim Wales

For queries regarding PVG for Scottish Swimming members, please email wellbeingprotection@scottishswimming.com. For queries regarding DBS for Swim Wales members, please email welfare@swimwales.org.

PLEASE NOTE: Scottish Swimming, Swim Wales and International Poolside Passes must be created and sent manually. They will be sent out prior to the event if you have the appropriate Safeguarding checks and qualifications on file.

















Minimum Qualification/Requirements (specific to accredited role)

- Coaches Coaching Qualification or Assistant Coach Certificate
- Team Manager Team Manager Training Module 1 or 2 Certificate
- Chaperone Club authorisation to be acting in loco parentis on behalf of the Club

PLEASE NOTE: It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure a DBS is in place and a pass has been purchased to attend the event. Under no circumstances will any person be allowed entry to accredited areas without the relevant safeguarding checks in place and pass issued.



FILMING AND PHOTOGRAPHY

FILMING AND PHOTOGRAPHY POLICY

Aquatics GB are aware of the wide range of devices including mobile telephones which have photographic and filming capabilities. This enables the capture of both static and moving images. It should be acknowledged that the majority of images taken within an Aquatics GB setting are appropriate and taken in good faith. However, images of children and adults can be misused, and sharing images widely without consent may betray a confidence or identify of a child or adult, which could present a risk of harm to that individual if common sense procedures are not followed.

Parents and carers of participants under the age of 18 who wish to take images are requested to focus on their own children as much as reasonably possible and to avoid including other children in images, particularly if those images are being shared with family and friends or through social media platforms. Whilst it is acknowledged that parents/carers wish to celebrate the achievements of their own children when taking part in aquatic events, it should be recognised and respected that other parents/carers may not wish for their child's image to be taken and shared in this way.

Aquatics GB encourage all spectators and participants at Aquatics GB events to make themselves familiar with the photography and filming arrangements for the event and be vigilant during that event.

Aquatics GB is committed to ensuring that all children who participate in Aquatics GB activities can take part in an enjoyable, safe environment and be safeguarded from harm. If you have any child safeguarding concerns at the event, please contact an Event Officer immediately to disclose your concerns.

EVENT PHOTOGRAPHY AND FILMING

This event **will be photographed and live streamed**. Static images will be displayed on the Aquatics GB website <u>here</u>. They will be used to promote the sport at this event and events in the future. Moving images may be displayed at the venue and via live stream <u>here</u>. In addition, Aquatics GB may use these recordings and images for the purposes of education and training, swimmer analysis, promotion, performance, development and selection and event analysis.

















In such instances where the event is being live streamed, it will not be possible to provide the option to refuse consent to filming and if there are any concerns, please speak to the Event Officer present. However, if individuals wish to refuse consent to static photography, please complete the Photography Refusal of Consent Form below and return to Aquatics GB Events Department.

If you, as a Parent/Guardian/Carer, have concerns about your child being photographed/filmed, please refer to the relevant Home Nation guidance document: Wavepower the Swim England Child Safeguarding Policy and Procedures; YPlant the Swim Wales Child Protection Policy; Scottish Swimming Child Protection Policy. If you have any concerns in this area, please contact the Data Protection Officer.
