

2025 European Aquatics Swimming (25m) Championships LUBLIN, Poland, 2nd-7th December 2025 SELECTION POLICY

1. POLICY PURPOSE

1.1. This selection policy outlines the process of selecting the swimming (pool) team to represent Great Britain at the 2025 European Aquatics Swimming (25m) Championships.

2. PERFORMANCE OBJECTIVES

- 2.1 The objectives for this event are:
 - 2.1.1 To provide international championship race experience for athletes on a trajectory for selection at the Los Angeles 2028 Olympic Games in pool swimming (individual and relay events).
 - 2.1.2 To provide valuable high-level race experience for athletes on a trajectory to win medals on the world senior stage (50m) in individual and relay events.

3. TEAM SIZE

- 3.1 Up to a maximum of 30 athletes will be selected for the 2025 European Aquatics Swimming (25m) Championships. There is no obligation on Aquatics GB (AGB) to select 30 athletes and the total team size will be determined by the Performance Director (PD) at his complete discretion, and subject to available budget.
- 3.2 Up to a maximum of four (4) athletes per individual event and one (1) relay team per event can be selected.

4. SELECTION PROCESS

- 4.1 Finalists in individual events from the 2025 World Aquatics Championships, Singapore 27th July 3rd August 2025 will be invited for selection onto the team. Places will be confirmed by the GB Head Coach after discussions between the athlete and their home coach.
- 4.2 Remaining places, up to the maximum team size determined under clause 3.1, will be selected at the complete discretion of the Performance Director and GB Head Coach in consultation with the swimming Performance Pathway Lead, in consideration to the objectives listed in clause 2. Performances at national and international meets from the period 1st April 2025 to 31st October 2025 will be considered.

5. SELECTION NOTIFICATIONS

5.1 All athletes selected will be notified by email on or before 7th November 2025.

SELECTION POLICY GENERAL CONDITIONS

ELIGIBILITY

Swimmers must:

- G1 Be a British citizen and eligible to represent Great Britain as per the appropriate World Aquatics (WA) rules.
- G2 Have completed a Selection Acceptance Form to confirm they will be available to participate by the deadline to be imposed by Aquatics GB. Failure to do so will be interpreted as non-availability by Aquatics GB. Selection Acceptance Forms will be provided by Aquatics GB to qualifying team members.
- G3 Be available to fulfil all team commitments from the time of selection through to the Championships.
- G4 Comply with any other WA eligibility criteria from time to time, including in respect of nationality and/or anti-doping.

TEAM COMMITMENTS

All Team members will be required to:

- G5 Comply with the Aquatics GB Code of Conduct. A breach of the Aquatics GB Code of Conduct may result in de-selection from the team.
- G6 Adhere to all prescribed travel arrangements which might involve different travel dates to other members of the team.
- G7 Abide by media protocols of the Aquatics GB swimming programme. Athletes must only speak to the media about their own performances and group coaches must only comment on performances of swimmers in their group. The GB Head Coach and Performance Director may discuss performances of the entire team. Swimmers must not publicise any information in relation selection-related matters until authorised to do so by the Team Leader.
- G8 Not take holiday or attend overseas camps and/or competitions between the selection trials and the meet for which they have been selected without prior written approval from the Performance Director.
- Make themselves available for all team activities designated by the GB Head Coach (including but not limited to preparation camps and staging camps). No team member will be allowed to leave a national team camp or undertake any activities that are not directly relevant to the team camp programme; this includes any external media, sponsor or social activities. Failure to attend the required activities could result in withdrawal from the team. Under exceptional circumstances, written approval to be excluded from activities may be given by the Performance Director.
- G10 Comply with Aquatics GB and WA swimwear regulations whilst competing at the 2025 European Aquatics Championships (25m).

WITHDRAWALS AND REPLACEMENTS

- G11 If for any reason a swimmer is unable or unwilling to fully comply with the Team Commitments (G5 to G10) they may be withdrawn from the team.
- G12 Swimmers becoming unfit due to illness or injury (physical or mental) at any time following their selection must notify Aquatics GB immediately and will be required to undertake a full medical examination which <u>may</u> result in the swimmer being de-selected from the team at the complete discretion of the GB Head Coach. In the event of injury or illness athletes may be deselected if they pose a risk to themselves, other athletes or team staff as determined by the Aquatics GB Chief Medical Officer or her designate.

REPLACEMENTS

G13 Replacement of swimmers withdrawn from the team will be considered at the complete discretion of the GB Head Coach in the best interest of the overall team performance.

OTHER

- G14 The World Class Programme Swimming Leadership Team may amend selection policies, within reason at its discretion.
- G15 The Performance Director and GB Head Coach will exercise their authority to ensure that the final selections for the 2025 European Aquatics Swimming (25m) Championships team are in line with this policy.

APPEALS

G16 Any appeals against non-selection must be made to Aquatics GB in accordance with the British Swimming Team Selection Appeals Procedures, available online at https://www.britishswimming.org/performance/swimming/selection-policies/team-selection-appeals/ or by request from Adam Clarke, Performance Strategy and Operations Director via email adam.clarke@aquaticsgb.com. Athletes should be aware of the time limits contained in the Procedures, which are designed with the intention of resolving issues expeditiously and fairly.
