ARRIVAL

Either on arrival for your first day, or the afternoon before, please make your way to the Front Desk to collect your accreditation and, where applicable, uniform and equipment. The Front Desk will be located in Ponds Forge Reception.

FRONT DESK

The Front Desk will be open for the last 2 training days $(25^{th} - 26^{th} \text{ May})$ and every competition day $(27^{th} - 29^{th} \text{ May})$, selling merchandise and programmes.

Spectator tickets must be brought through the link once available prior to entering the Venue. They will go on sale on Monday 23rd May @ 10am.

ACCREDITATION

Accreditation is being used at this event and must be worn visibly at all times when inside the venue. Coaches and athletes should print and bring their own accreditation to the event.

Poolside passes (for coaches, team managers, support staff etc.) are available to purchase for £10 on the British Swimming website here">here.

CLOTHING

British Diving Speedo Grey polo shirts will be used. These were new as of April 2022 and will be issued on the basis of one shirt for every two days in attendance. If you attended a British Diving event since April and have been issued these polo shirts please bring them with you.















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All other clothing must be unbranded. Please keep in mind that it will be particularly warm in the pool hall. Please wear suitable non-slip footwear- preferably trainers. Please wear black or dark colour trousers, long shorts or leggings. Officials have their own clothing guidelines. PARKING

Hotel

Hotel Parking is available and is chargeable at £12.50 per 24 hours.

Venue

Since Ponds Forge is still open to the Public, parking at the venue is limited therefore we recommend using Public Transport to travel to the venue or to park in Q-Park Castlegate, 3 Broad Street West Sheffield S1 2BQ. This public car park is located opposite Ponds Forge.

At Q-Park you need to collect a ticket and take it to Ponds Forge reception, there you can either scan it in the Q Park machine or collect a hard copy voucher. This entitles you to 50% off parking at the Q-Park.

EXPENSES

All expenses are paid post event by BACS. British Swimming have a preferred process of submitting expenses to their finance team via an online app called webexpenses. This is also the most efficient way of submitting and claiming your expenses.

















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We will send a list of all staff and volunteers attending this event to British Swimming Finance team who will then set you up on webexpenses should you not be already.

Please ensure that you add you Vehicle Details into the Vehicle Details tab in the Settings to allow you to add your mileage to your claim. Also, please ensure that you add your bank details into the general tab in the Settings.

If you have issues setting up your webexpenses account or submitting your webexpenses claim please email louise.betts@swimming.org who will be able to help.

Mileage is reimbursed at £0.45 per mile per vehicle. Calculating mileage should be done on a "Google maps fastest route" basis unless we are informed otherwise of a different route being taken.

Lunches will be provided at the pool every day, but you can claim £15 per night for evening meals (including one alcoholic drink). This is a 'per night' claim and not a total amount across the week.

PLEASE NOTE: Full, itemised VAT receipts must be provided for all meals with the relevant expenses clearly highlighted. Please note our finance department will not accept card receipts alone when attached to a claim. Additionally, the first expense payments will be made on the week commencing 13th June due to the upcoming Bank Holiday Weekend the week following the event.

Please note that receipts are required at British Swimming for ALL claims except mileage. This includes bus and taxi receipts.

CATERING
