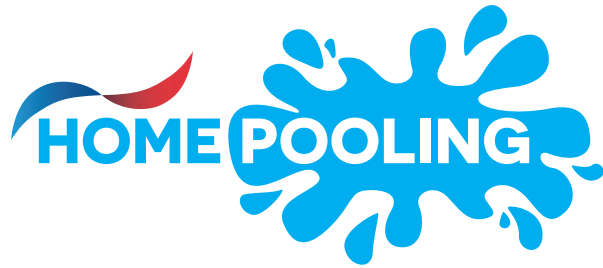

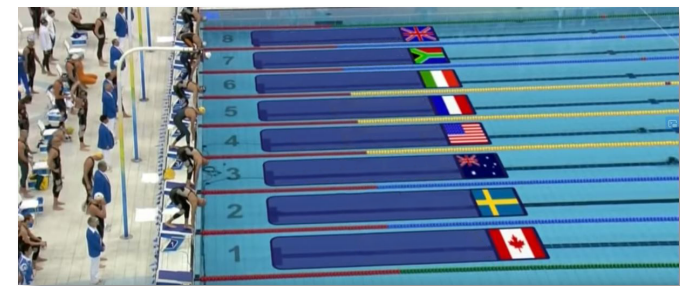
PART TWO
